4. First aid measures

If inhaled : Remove person to fresh air. If signs/symptoms continue, get medical attention.
Keep patient warm and at rest.
If unconscious, place in recovery position and seek medical advice.
Keep respiratory tract clear.
If breathing is irregular or stopped, administer artificial respiration.

In case of skin contact : Take off all contaminated clothing immediately.
Wash off immediately with soap and plenty of water.
Get medical attention immediately if irritation develops and persists.
Wash clothing before reuse.
Thoroughly clean shoes before reuse.

In case of eye contact : Rinse immediately with plenty of water, also under the eyelids, for at least 10 minutes.
Seek medical advice.

If swallowed : Move the victim to fresh air.
If unconscious, place in recovery position and seek medical advice.
Keep respiratory tract clear.
Do NOT induce vomiting.
Rinse mouth with water.
Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

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5. Firefighting measures

- Suitable extinguishing media : Use water spray, alcohol-resistant foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide.
- Unsuitable extinguishing media : High volume water jet

- Special protective equipment for firefighters : In the event of fire, wear self-contained breathing apparatus. Use personal protective equipment. In the case of respirable dust and/or fumes, use self-contained breathing apparatus. Exposure to decomposition products may be a hazard to health.

6. Accidental release measures

- Personal precautions : Evacuate personnel to safe areas. Use personal protective equipment. Ensure adequate ventilation. Do not breathe vapours or spray mist. Refer to protective measures listed in sections 7 and 8.
- Environmental precautions : Try to prevent the material from entering drains or water courses. Prevent further leakage or spillage if safe to do so. Local authorities should be advised if significant spillages cannot be contained.
- Methods for cleaning up : Contain spillage, and then collect with non-combustible absorbent material, (e.g. sand, earth, diatomaceous earth, vermiculite) and place in container for disposal according to local / national regulations (see section 13).

7. Handling and storage

Handling

- Advice on safe handling : Do not breathe vapours or spray mist. Avoid contact with skin and eyes. For personal protection see section 8.



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Smoking, eating and drinking should be prohibited in the application area.
Wash hands and face before breaks and immediately after handling the product.
Do not get in eyes or mouth or on skin.
Do not get on skin or clothing.
Do not ingest.
Do not repack.
Do not re-use empty containers.

Keep container closed when not in use.

Storage

Requirements for storage areas and containers : Store in original container.
Keep container closed when not in use.
Keep in a cool place away from acids.
Keep in a dry, cool and well-ventilated place.
Containers which are opened must be carefully resealed and kept upright to prevent leakage.
Store in accordance with the particular national regulations.
Keep in properly labelled containers.
